Gift Aid allows charities to reclaim income tax of £2.50 on every gift £10 received, whatever the amount. For our church to reclaim the tax, the donor must have paid sufficient income tax or capital gains tax in the same year to cover the amount reclaimed. All you need to do is to complete the Gift Aid Declaration.

This declaration covers all gifts, whether cash in envelopes in the collection plate, standings orders, cheques or 'one off' gifts.

Whichever way you give, the Gift Aid Secretary must be able to identify you as the donor, but all records remain confidential.
