## CORONAVIRUS TEST AND TRACE

### VISITOR INFORMATION

#### 1. VISITOR RECORDS TO SUPPORT NHS TEST AND TRACE

The UK is currently experiencing a public health emergency as a result of the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. If people who have recently come into close contact with the virus can be identified quickly further transmission can be minimised. In order that we can help contain any clusters or outbreaks we have been requested to keep a temporary record of your visit to the Church and to share this with the Test and Trace Service if required.

#### 2. REQUIRED INFORMATION

We need to collect the following information:

- Name
- A Contact phone number
- Date of visit
- Arrival time and, where possible, departure time

#### 3. USE OF YOUR INFORMATION

Your information will only be given to contracted Public Health England NHS Test and Trace staff if they request this data is needed to help contain a coronavirus cluster or outbreak. Your information will be held securely for 21 days and will not be used for any other purposes.

#### 4. CONTACT BY TEST AND TRACE

If it is found that you have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for coronavirus you will be contacted by the NHS Test and Trace Service using the contact number that was provided at your visit. Further action that you need to take will be agreed between you and the Test and Trace Service.
